Return to Campus Plan 2020

Our Return to Campus plan includes welcoming our Pre-K -5th grade students back to classrooms for part time in-person learning using a hybrid A/B schedule. We know it is most difficult for our learners to work independently, so bringing them back to the classroom will allow them to work in small groups and develop social skills and academic skills that will be the foundation for future learning. After careful consideration and input from a variety of stakeholders, our target date for bringing back our learners will be **Monday, October 19**. This is the Monday following Fall Break.

Before they return, students will be identified as either Group A or Group B. Depending on that assignment, students will either attend in-person school, for the full day on Monday & Tuesday or Thursday & Friday. All students will have assignments for remote learning the three days of the week that they are not in the classroom. You will receive your A/B assignment from your classroom teacher on **October 2nd**. We have arranged the schedule so that entire families will be placed on the same schedule. (Ex: All Jones on the A Schedule)

It is our intention to have no more than 13 students in a classroom at a time during this phase of our Return to Campus plan.

So, what does this mean for families on October 19?

- All students will attend school in-person two full days a week starting October 19, 2020. Students will be provided with learning activities to complete on their own at home during the other 3 days of the week.
- Students will bring their Chromebooks back to school with them for in class use and they will remain at school.
- Meals will be provided to students who are attending school in-person. Students will either eat in the cafeteria while social distancing or in their classrooms. Drive thru meal services will still be available from 11:30 am to 12:30 pm for remote learners.
- Uniform guidelines allow students to wear any solid white, light grey or navy shirt, along with khaki, black or navy pants/skirt/shorts.

Safety Protocols for students include:

- Students will wear a face covering that covers both the nose and mouth (SHA can provide one if needed). In addition, face shields have been purchased for student use.
- Students' temperatures will be taken upon arrival to school. If a student has a temperature of over 100.4 or more, they will be asked to return home.
- Students will be asked to wash their hands several times a day and/or use hand sanitizer.
- Students will also practice social distancing when applicable.
- Teachers will wear PPE and wipe down surfaces that are touched frequently.
- UV lights & chemical foggers will be used after hours to disinfect areas.
- Additional safety measures are outlined in the Return to Learn Plan on the SHA website.
- Nightly cleaning will occur in addition to deep cleaning each Wednesday and Saturday between learner groups.

Any family who does not wish to return to in-person learning on October 19 may opt into our Distance Learning program. The support for this will change and include required Zoom sessions that will be conducted each Wednesday. If you plan on remaining in Virtual Learning please contact the school directly to make that change no later than Wednesday, September 30.
